9.1 FIRST READING(S)

- 9.1.1 An Ordinance Authorizing and Approving the Development of a Jointly Owned and Operated Multi-County Industrial/Business Park in Conjunction with Jasper County (The “Park”). Such Industrial/Business Park to be Geographically Located in Jasper County (The “County”) and Established Pursuant to Section 4-1-170 of the Code of Laws of South Carolina 1976. As Amended (The “Act”); Providing for a Written Park Agreement with Jasper County to Provide for the Expenses and the Distribution of Fees In Lieu of Ad Valorem Taxes for the Park; Providing for the Establishment and/or Expansion of Certain Facilities by Project Silverstar, Acting for Itself, One or More Affiliates, and/or Other Project Sponsors (Collectively, The “Company”) in the County (The “Project”) to be Included in the Park; Providing for the Benefits of a Multi-County Industrial or Business Park to be Made Available to The Company and The Project; and Other Matters Relating Thereto. (Project Silverstar)
